

Strips 1, 5, 9, 13:

Strip Style: Plain Strip Width: 10"

Strips 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12:

Strip Style: Plain

Strip Width: 21/4"

Strip Height: 80"

Strips 3, 7, 11:

Strip Style: Pieced Blocks

Strip Width: 10" Strip Height: 80"

Number of Blocks: 8

Finished Size of Blocks: 10" x 10"

Total Blocks: 24 Economy Patch Blocks

Number of Borders: 2

Binding: 10 strips, 21/4" wide

† After the body of your quilt top is finished, please measure horizontally and vertically through the center of your quilt. If the body of your quilt top does not measure 84" x 80½", you will need to adjust the following lengths of your borders to fit.

#### Border 1:

Border Style: Long Horizontal
Finished Widths: Left: 0" Top: 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Right: 0" Bottom: 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"
Cut (2) strips at 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 84" †

#### Border 2:

Border Style: Long Horizontal
Finished Widths: Left: 0" Top: 8½" Right: 0" Bottom: 8½"
Cut (2) strips at 9" x 84" †

#### Cutting out the Economy Patch Blocks

At the end of these directions are three different options for constructing one of the Economy Patch Blocks - rotary cutting, templates, and foundation pattern - all generated from Electric Quilt 5.

Foundation Pattern Notes: The entire pattern does not fit on one page, because this is a 10½" x 10½" unfinished block on 8½" x 11" paper. Before you cut out the foundation patterns, line up the two pages on a light box or in front of a window. Use the long and short dashed lines as your guide and tape the two pages together to get the full pattern.








### Sewing the Economy Patch Blocks

#### Constructing the Quilt

- 1. Make 24 Economy Patch Blocks.
- 2. Using the quilt pictured as a guide, sew 8 Economy Patch blocks together into a row. Repeat this two more times so you have 3 separate rows of 8 blocks.
- 3. Measure the length of a row of Economy Patch blocks. It should measure 80 1/2". If your measurements are different, you will need to adjust the length of the strips cut in the following steps to fit your blocks.
- 4. From the 2 1/4 yards of your floral print 5560-01, cut (3) 10 1/2"x 80 1/2" strips (or cut to fit your Economy Patch rows).
- 5. From the 2 3/8 yards of 5560-01, cut (1) 10 1/2" x 85 1/2" strip and (2) 9" x 85 1/2" strips. Trim the 10 1/2" wide strip to 10 1/2" x 80 1/2" (or cut to fit your Economy Patch rows).
- 6. From the 2 1/2 yards of your stripe 5565-21, cut (8) 2 3/4" x 90".
- 7. Cut (5) 2 1/2" x 90" strips from the remaining stripe fabric for the binding.
- 8. Trim six of the 2 3/4" x 90" strips cut in step 6 to 2 3/4" x 80 1/2" (or cut to fit your Economy Patch rows). Sew a strip to either side of each of your Economy Patch rows.
- 9. Using the quilt pictured as a guide, alternate the 10 1/2" wide large focal strips with your pieced rows and sew.
- 10. Refer to the Quilt Information page to cut the borders for your quilt top
- 11. Sew a long strip from step 6 to the top and bottom of your quilt top.
- 12. Sew a long focal strip from step 5 to the top and bottom of your quilt top.
- 13. Quilt, Bind, and Enjoy.







